Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award Training Day

The Bronze Award training day will take place on Saturday, 25th February, 2012, at Farlington School commencing at 9.00am; please ensure your daughter is here before that time. This is an important step in the expedition training programme and it is imperative that your daughter attends. The day will be run by me, assisted by various members of staff who have given up their time to help. The day is planned to run until approximately 3.00pm but, depending on progress, may well finish earlier.

Most of the day will be spent outdoors so plenty of warm clothing needs to be worn. Each person is to bring the following equipment;

- Walking boots.
- Waterproof clothing.
- Day sack.
- A change of footwear (trainers or the like).
- Water/Juice.
- Snacks.
- Bowl or plate, mug and cutlery.
- A share of the ingredients to cook a two course lunch for each team member. This will be discussed at one of the training sessions prior to the training day. Cooking equipment will be supplied by the school.

If your daughter has not yet returned their medical and consent form for the training day and expeditions she must do so prior to commencement.
