University of Surrey Science and Engineering Lecture:
Fighting Crime and Cancer with Ion Beams

The University of Surrey have organised another lecture, 'Fighting Crime and Cancer with Ion Beams,' to which your daughter has expressed an interest in going. It will take place on Wednesday, 29th February, from 5.00-6.00pm. The talk will be delivered by Dr Melanie Bailey, who is currently working with the police to use ion beams (beams of charged particles) in forensic science. Particular uses include the analysis of trace evidence such as gunshot residue, soils and fingerprints.
