Dear Parents

Week commencing Monday, 20 February, I will be teaching Sex Education to your daughters. The National Curriculum and our own School Policy recommends that sex education should be taught at this age, although we do touch on various issues related to this topic from Year 3. I intend to cover this in Science lessons over the next few weeks.

In Prep 6, we cover the basic biology and go into more detail about the changes at puberty. As part of the course, we shall use a video which addresses puberty, intercourse, development and birth of a baby. This video is specifically aimed at Prep 6 age children and is produced in a sensitive and sympathetic way. I do hope that you will be receptive to any questions that your daughter may have and that you will be happy to continue any discussions at home.
